## 03 A. K-5 Mathematics Program

Assistant Superintendent, Dr. Anthony Buono, Curriculum Coordinator Lauren Skultety and the teachers gave a presentation on the proposed K-5 Mathematics Program. They discussed the process (paper screening, site visits to Guilford and Madison, and pilot lessons at each Branford elementary school). Their recommendation is that the Board adopt Bridges as the new program for the coming school year. Bridges aligns with the workshop model being used in Language Arts, is very hands-on through its "stations," is developmentally appropriate and yet rigorous, includes an online component with assistance for families, and is supported by the publisher throughout implementation. Ms. Toche reiterated her ongoing concern about students who do not have access to technology.
