Among the items discusses in this evening's update were; what we did (analyzed data to identify needs student and teacher, focused professional learning on foundational literacy, made systemic shifts to instruction, reviewed programs and assessments to support consistent practices and piloted elements of one program, which was selected by a comprehensive K-4 team) and initial outcomes of the Wonders Pilot (vocabulary has improved significantly - this is true of students' academic vocabulary, as well as other words, students are exposed to a lot of rich content, which builds from year to year, each grade has experience with process writing, as well as written response and students love having their own copies of common materials).

## 04 Future Topics: School Start Times

Ellen Michaels and the Committee members discussed the following; Ellen's past experience as an educator regarding school start time, an article in the Hartford Currant (nine states considering changing
