- C. Day spoke and noted there was great participation from everyone at the Special Meeting where Kathy Connolly spoke. She said she received a lot of volunteers for the upcoming Saturday clean-up day.
- P. Sweeney said he secured a speaker (David Gumbart, Director of Land Management for the Nature /Conservancy) for an upcoming meeting. He noted that Habitat Management is his specialty and he was a prior Inland Wetland Commissioner for Branford. He is also willing to speak for no fee. P. Sweeney will set up a date for the speaker.

Diana McCarthy (Town Hall employee) is organizing it. Chairman Fitzgerald asked the Commission to assist in giving out white oak tree samplings on Earth Day. He would like to purchase them (up to \$1,000) and discussed this with the Commission.
