- b) *Services* Updates were given on Social Services for fiscal year to date. The new Social Services CharityTracker database was also introduced to Board members. In the process of interviewing for a new case manager that will operate out of the Senior Center.
- VI. Public Relations/Fundraising: BCCS' 3rd Annual Charity Softball Game was a great success and raised over \$7,000 for the Basic Needs Program. BCCS awarded a scholarship to a Branford High School senior who will be pursuing a degree in the human services field. BCCS will also be at the Branford Festival.
- VII. Director's Report: Working with the Baptist Church in Branford to help identify residents in need of assistance with things such as landscaping or repairs as a part of their mission trips in the community. Also discussed the possibility of hiring a clinician that specializes in substance abuse with the funds from the opiate settlement money given to the town.
