- **2.) Additions to the agenda:** A proposal to extend the contract with the Construction Manager will be presented during the Building Committee report.

Development Committee—

Annual Appeal: So far, the appeal has raised \$5,000. Work continues on the May fundraising event to be held at the Stony Creek Brewery featuring Gina Barrecca. The Committee will meet in mid-January to work out the details.

Capital Campaign Committee—

Review of past month's activity: On November 28, the library announced an anonymous donation of \$150,000 to the renovation, making the total so far \$650,000! Board members are encouraged to identify more potential donors. On Sunday, January 28, there will be a reception held to thank all donors who have given \$1,000 and up; additional gifts will be announced. Karen sent renovation packages to the 7 new RTM members. So far, three members are coming to the library for renovation presentations.

Building Committee—

Update on progress: In order to ensure that the project cost remains within the projected budget, it is necessary to also bring on the construction manager for the balance of the preconstruction and bidding phase. **It was resolved:** that the Board authorizes extension of the construction manager contract with Downes Construction Co. to complete the Preconstruction & Bidding phase at a cost of \$34,000 to be funded by bequests assigned to the Capital Campaign. After discussion, Robin made a motion to approve the proposal. Polly Fitz seconded the motion. The motion was passed.
