Chairman Joseph Mooney called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. at Fire Headquarters. Meeting materials are posted on the Town's website (Branford-ct.gov) and are available for viewing during and after the meeting.

The meeting was also available for remote public viewing via BCTV/Comcast Channel 20 and Facebook Live.

The full board was present: Harry DiAdamo, Victor Cassella, Robert Imperato, Joseph Mooney, Charles Shelton, Jr., and Jeffrey Vailette. Also present were James Cosgrove, First Selectman; Kathryn LaBanca, Assistant Finance Director; Lisa Arpin, Town Clerk; RTM reps in attendance were Tricia Anderson, Peter Black, Don Conklin, Ray Ingraham and Frank Twohill.

1. Citizen's Communications: Resident Wayne Cooke spoke for ten minutes on his handout topics, attached, regarding his concerns on the Animal Shelter renovation project analysis. Chairman Mooney referenced a letter received late today from Bobby Costanzo to be included with the minutes, also attached.
2. The Board heard a transfer request from Police Chief Jon Mulhern on behalf of the Board of Police Commissioners for the following FY2021 transfer. Chief Mulhern was happy to report being fully-staffed as of 7/1/2021.

**RESOLVED:** That the Board of Finance recommends to the RTM the transfer of \$210,546.31 and \$114,000.00 in the Police budget.

- The Board heard a presentation by Tax Collector Roberta Gill-Brooks requesting the approval of the Suspense List for the 2015 Grand List Year as of 6/22/2021 as indicated below. A discussion on training and collection activities also took place. A glitch in the QDS software has caused the monthly collections report to the Board to be delayed, but hoping to present accurate numbers at next month's meeting.

Mr. Imperato made the motion to approve the Suspense List as presented, seconded by Mr. Valette, with the vote being unanimous.

- To continue discussions on the Dan Cosgrove Animal Shelter facility expansion appropriation, and consider, and if appropriate, approve the transfer requests and resolutions below.

The Board heard an update by Laura Burban, Director of Dan Cosgrove Animal Shelter (DCAS) regarding fundraising efforts and as of now, more than 60% of donors are from Branford and North Branford. DCAS Commission members have donated a total of \$278,000 to date, and are extremely invested as well. Currently, approximately 1,333 individuals, businesses, and/or foundations have donated to the project. At this past Thursday's fundraising event a local business owner donated \$150,000 toward the construction of the facility. A donor from NJ who previously donated \$5,000 increased her donation at the fundraiser by an additional \$25,000 to ensure the project would move forward.

Chairman Mooney read Finance Director Jim Finch's memo of June 25, 2021, attached, and then the Board heard an update on details regarding the bidding process efforts, scopes and soft costs from Brian P. Baril, AIA, Director of Estimating at Enterprise Builders of Newington, CT. Mr. Baril also gave a recap on the \$1.7 increase. Questions were fielded from the Board regarding the VRF electric heat pump system, energy recovery ventilator and solar aspects of the project. First Selectman Jamie Cosgrove spoke on the Public Building Commission's role in selecting the Construction Manager, etc.

Chairman Mooney then read the following resolution:

**Resolved:** That the Board of Finance recommends to the RTM an appropriation from increased undesignated fund balance in the amount of \$650,000. This transfer will increase the Fiscal year 2021 General Fund budget from \$118,867,730 to \$119,517,730 and will be used to partially fund the animal shelter renovation.

Mr. DiAdamo made the motion to approve the resolution, seconded by Mr. Valette, with the vote being unanimous.

In addition, Chairman Mooney read the following transfers to reflect the impact on the general fund and capital fund.

Dear Branford Board of Finance:

Your June 15, 2021 Board meeting had a robust discussion on both sides of approving the \$1.7 million increase to fund the Animal Shelter expansion and renovation. While both sides stated their case either for or against the budget increase from the original \$2,895,000.; I applaud the BOF for unanimously voting to table any action at that time.

I understand your collective need to process the information in hand and also additional information provided to the board since that meeting.

The one thing I believe that all agree on, is the need for some form of expansion and renovation at the shelter. There is very strong support from both sides of the construction budget increase issue for the goal of a better shelter. This is evidenced by the generous donations given to off-set the burden on the citizen taxpayers, that exceeded the set goal.

I for one strongly support the making the shelter function better for both the dedicated staff and the animals that are sheltered, but I also strongly believe in the BOF's responsibility to act responsibly with tax payer's money. If the budget was off by a staggering \$1.7 million, maybe the project should be put on hold until the plans are fully vetted. Recommend that the plans be sent back to the drawing board, if need be, to make reasonable changes that can be built for the budgeted amount.

**As an example:** I like a reliable, and efficient vehicle that can transport me safely to and from work, and for pleasure on week-ends. My budget allows me to purchase a Ford Escape. I wanted a Tesla Model X, but that was double the price. I tried to justify the energy cost savings, and was tempted to take a 72-month loan instead of a 36-month loan. In the end I bought the Ford, because the cost savings of gas to electricity, and the 36 extra months of payments simply was not fiscally responsible. All the smoke and mirrors could not justify the price tag of the Tesla Model X.

There have been all sorts of reasons given why the budget ballooned by \$1.7 million, and scenarios given to justify and / or offset the extra spending.

The expansion plans were just preliminary or conceptual which left items out.

The price of construction has risen steeply during the covid-19 slow down.

We exceeded our fundraising goal, so it helps off-set the increase,

Branford can negotiate a deal with North Branford to share in the construction cost.

Branford can secure additional financing for the \$1.7 million and spread the principle and cost of debt out over 15 years. It is still not "FREE" money.

There may be some good ideas in there, that would be **GREAT** ideas if we used them, but stuck to the original budget. The original \$2.9 million budget in itself is a substantial sum, with some creativity, compromise and open mindedness, Branford can have a very fine animal shelter with that budget.

Finally, I have watched many building projects over the past 45 years I've lived in Branford, and can't remember anytime when they were built on time and with-in budget. It is a given that there will be over-runs and change orders issued throughout the project that will further increase the projected cost of the project which will further burden the tax payers.

Please vote responsibly tonight, and not be pressured into making a decision that all tax-payers will have to live with, under the assumption that you have to act quickly at any expense.

I attach for your review and consideration a resolution to increase the appropriation for the shelter renovation from \$2,895,000 to \$4,595,000. For reference I am attaching a copy of the letter I sent on July 11th as it summarizes the approach and actions required. Following the last meeting, I understood that the board was looking to receive additional information from the construction manager, an update on fundraising efforts and finally a scenario that reduced the costs to future taxpayers below \$306,000. My sense was the board supported the shared framework approach.

To assist the board I have attached a spreadsheet which provides a comparison of the following scenarios:

- The original appropriation from last fall.
- The request as outlined in my letter from the last meeting.
- A scenario reducing the cost to future taxpayers from \$306,000 to \$250,000.
- A better case scenario.
- A worst case scenario.

As the board is familiar with the first two columns I will include a brief discussion on the remaining columns.

Approaches to reduce the cost to future taxpayers from 306,000 to \$250,000:

As we discussed at the last meeting, some of the revenue components are interconnected and thus an adjustment to one variable may present unintended challenges for the other components. As an example, if the board were to increase the appropriation from fund balance, it would impact the amount North Branford would be required to pay during the next five years. Admittedly this is doable, however, it may not be received favorably since it is inconsistent with North Branford's prior expectations.

Alternatively asking the shelter commission and staff to raise an additional \$56,000 would be an easier task as this would simply result in a minor change to the bond resolution.

Better case scenario:

Under this scenario all things go our way with donations exceeding expectations and North Branford is fully on board with all of their related commitments (fund balance, debt service etc.)

Worst case scenario:

Admittedly one can develop many combinations of scenarios with varying levels of commitment from each of the stakeholders. Essentially these scenarios, as well as mine, are not guaranteed as they are based on probable outcomes. Therefore, the approach outlined in the worst case scenario takes the position that one should not focus on the probability of an unfavorable outcome but rather the consequence of an unfavorable outcome. Essentially this exercise forces decision makers to determine if an approach is worth pursuing after considering the risks and whether these risks will result in an outcome for which the recovery is slow and painful.

The worst case scenario assumes donations remain static based on the original budget and that none of these donations are earmarked for Sustainable CT (See notes) matching funds. Finally the scenario assumes that North Branford partners with another community thereby escaping any previous commitments to Branford.

Other considerations:

I want to underscore for the board, as well as the RTM, that approval of this resolution commits the town to funding the full amount of the appropriation and that shortfalls in the other revenue sources will be offset with borrowing. The challenge in financing this project is to strive for a "goldilocks" scenario in which the amount borrowed perfectly matches the net amount required from non-debt sources. If we ultimately realize excess bond proceeds we will reallocate these dollars to project(s) with unfinanced balances.

Conclusion:

This memo along with the attached worksheet is intended to provide additional scenarios to assist you in your decision. I have also included an attachment with revised resolutions and transfers. Please note that if your decision differs from the attachment it will require amendments to the resolution. I will also go over this with Kathryn before the meeting.

Notes:

*Sustainable CT's **Community Match Fund** is an innovative program that provides fast, flexible funding and support for engaging your community on wide-ranging sustainability projects. Eligible projects receive **dollar-for-dollar** matching funds from Sustainable CT.*

*The Town of Branford has twice used the community match fund for previous campaigns. The shelter would be the third match fund campaign and is expected to generate \$25,000 in donations with an anticipated \$25,000 match from Sustainable CT. Energy efficiency is a top priority for the Community Match Fund which makes the shelter a great candidate for this initiative. The funding will cover any incremental cost from the energy savings technology used in the construction of the new and renovated building.*

RESOLUTION AMENDING A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$2,895,000 FOR THE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF THE BRANFORD ANIMAL SHELTER AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$2,895,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN TO MEET SAID APPROPRIATION AND PENDING THE ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE

Section 1. The Resolution adopted September 9, 2020, entitled "RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$2,895,000 FOR THE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF THE BRANFORD ANIMAL SHELTER AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$2,895,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN TO MEET SAID APPROPRIATION AND PENDING THE ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE", which is hereby ratified, confirmed and adopted, is amended by increasing the appropriation and bond authorization by \$1,700,000 to a total of \$4,595,000 as follows:

Section 2. The title of the Resolution is amended to read as follows:

RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$4,595,000 FOR THE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF THE BRANFORD ANIMAL SHELTER AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$4,595,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN TO MEET SAID APPROPRIATION AND PENDING THE ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE

Section 3. Section 2 of the Resolution is amended by substituting the following:

The total estimated cost of the project is \$4,595,000 and is expected to be paid from an estimated \$1,315,500 to be raised for the project pursuant to a capital campaign of public contributions, energy rebates, fund balance from the Town of Branford, contributions from the Town of North Branford, and the balance from the bonds authorized herein.

Section 4. The first sentence of section 3 of the Resolution is amended to read as follows:

"To meet said appropriation, \$4,595,000 bonds of the Town or so much thereof as shall be necessary for such purpose, shall be issued, maturing not later than the twentieth year after their date."

Section 5. The Resolution is further amended by substituting the amount of \$4,595,000 for \$2,895,000, wherever it appears in the Resolution.
