They enroll for the 12 month program but end up pulling the children out in June. The SR slots are for 12 months and in order to qualify they must attend the entire time. Michele would like to have this discussion put on the agenda for next month.

Family Resource Center will be giving back one SR slot to Branford Early Learning Center on September 1st. (Note: this slot was "borrowed" to accommodate a family that had a child already attending FRC and instead of having her sibling at another site the slot was moved to FRC for the remainder of this school year.)
