It was agreed at a previous meeting to spend approximately 2,500.00 for a social marketing program offered by Mosaic in Branford. The entire committee agreed with the new recommendation. The subcommittee will ask Jamie to issue a PO to proceed.

**Buildings.** Greg reported that the Animal Shelter is almost completed. We are on schedule to have a "Net Zero" building. Greg was given the okay to request an RFP for solar for the Animal Shelter. Greg is now the liaison to the Animal Shelter project representing the Public Building commission. Greg asked for help on an update on the Police Station project.

**Verogy.** Diana led a discussion regarding how the Verogy program works differently than the Net Metering process we are all familiar with. Diana is reviewing which town meters to link with Verogy and we can adjust annually to improve our energy efficiency.

**HeatSmart.** Mike reported he and Dan had a productive meeting with the North Haven Clean Energy committee regarding their invitation to discuss the HeatSmart program. Guilford will be postponing HeatSmart discussions until September.

**Charging Stations within town.** Diana reported the town is looking at Charging Stations at the Animal Shelter, High School, Foote Park, and the main Fire Station.

SustainableCT: Diana is assembling points for Branford to attain silver or bronze status and enable us to apply for the climate leadership designation. Sharon, Greg, and Dan have provided clean energy actions.
