Transportation, Transit & Infrastructure DOT Sybil Creek bridge project: estimated start January 2020, through December 2020; Limewood Ave. seawall: estimated start Fall 2020, through Spring 2021. Snake Hill Rd. target completion April 2020. I-95's Exit 55 bridge construction continues until November 20<sup>th</sup>, resuming in spring 2020, completion expected October 2020.

## 2. Town Center

The Town Center merchants are celebrating Branford's 375th by displaying vintage photos of their buildings obtained through town historian Jane Bouley. The Town Center merchants held a successful summer sidewalk sale in early August. soundRUNNER and the Shoreline Greenway Trail are planning a series of hikes/walks in September to promote Branford's trails.

3. REX Development

REX is assisting a prospective buyer to secure funds to remediate two parcels on Beaver Rd.

## 4. Tourism

The Central CT Tourism District [65 towns] received its 2018-2019 state funding of \$1.2m in May, part of which funds the Greater New Haven Visitors & Relocation Guide published by REX / VisitNewHaven; Branford, North Branford and Guilford share an ad in the publication and Branford's Harrison House and 375th celebration are featured in the History section. The Shoreline Trolley Museum held a reception and facility tour on September 5th for Branford government and business leaders to showcase its capital project.
