BRANFORD GREEN COMMITTEE MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD APRIL 12, 2022

- 1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 5:34 pm
- 2. Parliamentary/Technical:
- a. **Minutes- David Colley** made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of February, 2021 and the special meeting of March 29, 2022. **Cynde** seconded the motion and, after due discussion they were approved with 5 yeas and 1 abstention.
- 3. Updates & Old Business:
- a. Correspondence- none.
- b. Status of the Green- Multiple issues were discussed including: i. the two art pieces on the Green have been removed; ii. the garbage pails along Main Street will be replaced with larger receptacles and will be emptied more often; iii. the new Christmas tree has been planted and will be featured as part of our Arbor Day ceremony later this month.
- c. Special Projects- tabled.
- d. **Planting Plan 2022-** the planting of a white oak adjacent to the Baptist Church and an eastern red cedar to the left of the Cenotaph were anticipated; the sycamores to be planted in back of Town Hall are delayed because sycamores are harder to find than their London plane tree cousins.
- 4. New Business:
- **a. Green Use Applications-** a number of applications for various events were presented and discussed.
- b. Reports- i. Garden Club- Pat reported various trees at the Blackstone Library have been assigned Q-codes for identification by a smart phone app.
 ii. Map/memorials- Pat reported the new Christmas tree will be marked as #18 on the updated
 - map; the new aerial map of the Green will be available shortly. Discussion of how to access it on the Town website; discussion of installing a memorial plaque in Town Hall to publicize donations of trees to the Green. Discussion of posting the map on the bulletin board in the Town Hall foyer.
- c. Possible Tree Donation- re-visited a possible tree donation from a local family.
- d. Arbor Day- see above regarding the new Christmas tree.
- 5. Other- Dave i. discussed the possibility of having a representative from the *Notable Trees Program* visit the Green to update its inventory; ii. the white spruce tree donated by Shirley McCarthy was planted; iii. discussion of producing an informational tri-fold to place in the

Town Hall foyer and /or placing informational notices/the map on the Town Hall foyer bulletin board; **iv. Cynde** and **Susan McNamara** will approach Town officials regarding beautification of the portable toilets on the Green.

6. **Adjourn-** upon motion by **Cynde** and seconded by **Pat**, after due discussion the motion was approved unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 6:25PM.
