- <u>Ryan McEvoy</u> pointed to where the sediment and erosion controls failed during the past rainstorm.
- <u>Michael Digioia</u> pointed to the slope that's to be excavated behind lots 10, 11, and 12 and informed the Commission that he will be hauling the material to an area in Branford as opposed to the previous area that's still not ready to receive it. He noted that it's about a week and a half worth of work.
- <u>The Commission</u> walked the property and viewed proposed development lots, catch basins, silt fences, and the large catch water basin.
- <u>Michael Digioia</u> stated that he will be installing the biofilter, recommended by EO Ross, on the backside of the level spreader himself.
- <u>Michael Digioia</u> pointed to areas that will soon receive hydroseed and informed the commission of his plans to have it watered.
