## Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting March 2, 2022 (Revised by the Clerk) Fire Headquarters - 5:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. Present were First Selectman James B. Cosgrove, Second Selectwoman Angela M. Higgins and Third Selectman Raymond Dunbar. Also present were Attorney James Perito and Laura Burban, Director, Daniel Cosgrove Animal Shelter.

Motion made by Selectwoman Higgins to approve the minutes of February 16, 2022. Seconded by Selectman Dunbar. Vote unanimous.

Motion made by Selectwoman Higgins to enter into executive session to discuss pending tax appeals at 5:00 p.m. Seconded by Selectman Dunbar. First Selectman Cosgrove invited Attorney Perito to attend the executive session. Vote unanimous.

Present in executive session were: First Selectman James B. Cosgrove, Second Selectman Raymond Dunbar, Third Selectman Angela M. Higgins and Attorney James Perito.

Motion made by Selectwoman Higgins to return to regular meeting at 5:08 p.m. Seconded by Selectman Dunbar. Vote unanimous.

For the record no votes were taken while in executive session.

Motion made by Selectwoman Higgins to approve the proposed settlement in the Airgas v. Town of Branford tax appeal case as presented by Attorney Perito. Seconded by Selectman Dunbar. Vote unanimous.

Discussion took place concerning the request to waive bid for the purchase, installation and maintenance of surveillance cameras and Milestone camera software. *For the record Selectman Dunbar pointed out that the request for approval is for two quotes received from Omni Data one for the surveillance cameras and software and one for the security system components totaling \$58,430.62.*

Motion made by Selectwoman Higgins to approve a request from Laura Burban, Director, Dan Cosgrove Animal Shelter to waive the bid for the purchase, installation and maintenance of surveillance cameras and Milestone camera software and security system components at the Dan

Cosgrove Animal Shelter and award the contract to Omni Data in the amount of \$58,430.62. Seconded by Selectman Dunbar. Vote unanimous.
