Executive Session was removed from the agenda.

Motion made by Selectman Dunbar to approve a request from Brian Devlin, Superintendent, WPCF to waive bid for the disposal of grit/scum from the Waste Water Treatment Plant and award a three year contract with two -1 year extensions to All American Waste at a cost of \$449.39 per haul and \$350.00 per ton.

Motion made by Selectman Dunbar to approve a Solar Virtual Net Metering Credit Purchase Agreement between the Town of Branford and Verogy for a period of 20 years with three 5 year extensions. For the record it was noted that by way of approving the agreement effectively it also waives the bid process. Brian Fitzgerald provided additional information concerning the agreement. Seconded by Selectwoman Higgins. Vote unanimous.
