MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING: June 15, 2017

Approval of Minutes:

Motion made by Commissioner Grossman to approve the minutes of May 8, 2017. Seconded by Commissioner Lasala. Vote unanimous.

Report of the Chief:

Compstat Report – Chief Halloran reported that during the past month the department issued 283 tickets, 37 of which were for cell phone/distracted driver violations. He reported cases of significance including a person struck by an Amtrak train; person found deceased in the parking lot of Margarita's believed to be a heroin overdose; report of a shooting on North Branford Road; Burglary at the Elm Café; Identification made in a larceny case reported from 45 Grove Street; The Detective Division assisted the State of Connecticut Liquor Control Commission with compliance checks. YTD Part 1 Crimes down 2% from 2016.

Forfeiture Report: The Chief reported that the forfeiture balance is \$152,688.89.

Budget – Transfer to Capital account completed. The Budget passed the full RTM June 14, 2017.

Injury Report – Officer Herten returned to work after a motor vehicle accident, the cruiser was totaled.

Crime Analyst – the job was posted and 11 applications have been received.

Traffic Committee:


Chief Halloran extended his appreciation and gratitude to the officers that were involved in raising money for the Special Olympics.
