Motion made by Selectman Ahern to approve a request from John Hoefferle, Town Engineer to waive the bid for engineering construction services for Hemlock Pumping Station and award the contract to AECOM in the amount of \$138,085. Seconded by First Selectman Cosgrove. Vote unanimous.

Motion made by Selectman Ahern to approve the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the policies of the Town of Branford comply with nondiscrimination agreements and warranties of the Connecticut General Statues §§ 4a-60 and 4a-60a, as amended.

Seconded by First Selectman Cosgrove. Vote unanimous.

Motion made by Frist Selectman Cosgrove to approve the following resolution:

Be it resolved, that it is in the best interest of the Town of Branford to enter into contracts with the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection.
