Motion was made by Representative Black to re-refer and seconded by Representative Conklin. Passed 5-0.

**RESOLVED**: That the Ways and Means committee recommends to the RTM an appropriation from undesignated fund balance of \$646,000 to fund an appropriation for a school security system. This appropriation increases the Fiscal year 2023 General Fund budget from \$124,821,065 to \$125,467,065.

### Coastal Resiliency Fund

Increase: 700-90000-480296-23xx Fund Balance Transfer \$100,000 Increase: 740-43050-533280-23xx Cattle Crossing Design and Permitting \$100,000

Motion was made by Representative Black to approve and seconded by Representative Conklin. Passed 5-0.

**RESOLVED**: That the Ways and Means committee recommends to the RTM an appropriation of \$100,000 in the Coastal Resiliency Fund. This appropriation will be funded. through an appropriation from fund balance.
