WAYS AND MEANS REGULAR MEETING MAY 3, 2023 @ 7:00 p.m.

A regular meeting of the Ways and Means Committee was held on Wednesday May 3, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. at the Branford Community House, 46 Church Street, Branford, CT. Those in attendance were Representative Barron, Representative Black, Representative Conklin, Representative Erlanger, and Representative Healy. Also in attendance were Representatives Stres, Twohill, Prete, and Hynes and Superintendant Hernandez and Director of Technology Rob Kovi.

1. To approve the minutes of the April meeting.

Representative Black made a motion to approve and was seconded by Representative Barron. Passed 5-0.

2. To act upon budgets from the following departments:

Principal Debt Service.....Jim Finch Interest Debt Service Contingency Board of Finance.....Jim Finch Public Celebration.....Jim Finch Sewer Assessment Fund......Jim Finch Pensions and Contributions......Jim Finch/Margaret Luberda

Representative Black made a motion to approve the budgets as presented and was seconded by Representative Barron.

Passed 5-0.

3. To consider, and if appropriate, approve the following transfers in the current year to reduce tax requirements in the FY2024 requested budget:

Transfers from Fund Balance

Increase: 10190000-480296 Fund Balance \$540,800 Increase: 10150000-599110 Transfer Out-Capital Fund 700 \$540,800

Transfers Capital Fund 700

Increase: 700-90000-490010 Transfer In \$540,800 Increase: 700-48000-579400-23xx BOE Security System \$540,800

RESOLVED: That the Ways and Means committee recommends to the RTM an appropriation from undesignated fund balance of \$646,000 to fund an appropriation for a school security system. This appropriation increases the Fiscal year 2023 General Fund budget from \$124,821,065 to \$125,361,865.

A motion was made by Representative Conklin to amend the transfer amounts from \$646,600 to \$540,800 and was seconded by Representative Barron. Motion passed 4-0-1.

Motion was made to adjourn by Representative Erlanger and secondedby Representative Black at 8:12 p.m.
