- 1. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 4:01 pm
- 2. Attendance BHA Board Commissioners: Kate Collins via phone, Dawn Lynch, Andy Wight, Jerry Mastrangelo Beacon Management: John Elliott. Elly Nunez, Jen Foito, Todd Florio, Ebony Barnes
- **3. Review of Minutes** The minutes of December 19, 2023, 2023, were reviewed. Kate Collins made a motion to approve, and Dawn Lynch seconded. The Minutes were approved by all.
- **4. Financial Report** Kate Collins reported that the February income was in-line with the budget. Although the rents were increased, the ewrap subsidies were also.
