First Selectman Cosgrove read a letter requesting that the monthly stipend for the Town's band director be increased to \$500 monthly, or about \$50/hour for ten months of events. This would result in an increase of \$1812 to Seasonal and Part Time Help. The upcoming vote on the Contingency fund was identified as a potential place to offset.
