Special meeting, September 19, 2023, 4:00 pm - Annual Tree Walk

Minutes of Meeting

Attendance: David Minicozzi, Committee Chair, Don Gentile, Pat Sanders, Cynde Jasek, Ann Freeman, Sue Winkle, Joseph Cutrona, Cameron Pierce, Katie xxx, Cynthia Wright, Jamle Cosgrove, Alex Palozzi, Gary Zelinski.


David Minicozzi called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm and introduced Cameron xxx, of Davey Tree Expert Company, who led the walk.

- 1. The following action items were moved as a group and voted on during the meeting:
  - a. Remove D 27, Pagoda Dogwood
  - b. Remove D 21 Schwedler Maple
  - c. Remove B2, Norway Maple

Ann Freeman moved that the trees be removed, Pat Sanders seconded, motion carried. David Minicozzi noted that replacement or new trees would be discussed at the Committee's regular meeting on October 10.

- d. C 26, River Birch. Joe Cutrona noted that the tree roots are growing under and damaging the nearby sidewalk resulting in dangerous walking conditions. Joe proposed removing the tree. After discussion it was proposed that one of the three branches of the tree (the farthest branch from the church building) will be removed and Cameron Pierce recommended aggressive root trimming to encourage the roots to grow downward. A new blacktop will be installed. Joe accepted the recommendations and moved acceptance, Cynde Jacek seconded. Motion carried.
- 2. A 18, white spruce, (Holiday Tree). This tree is distressed as a result of toppling in a storm causing the roots to snap. Cameron noted aggressive treatment of the tree and observation. He is optimistic that it can be "saved".
- 3. B 25, Norway Maple. Tree is stressed and in need of pruning and will be observed for potential removal.
- 4. B14, Sugar Maple, discussion: it was noted that this tree is cabled to a utility pole and close to the utility lines. The utility company may want to remove, Gary Zelinski will follow-up).

- 5. C 13 Kwanzan Cherry, designated as a "Champion Tree"
- 6. Attached are recommendations for feeding, pruning, and general care of the trees on the Green under its current contract with the town. (I believe it is best to document Cameron's recommendations and I can add any appropriate additional observations.)
