MINUTES from: October 2, 2024 held at Joe Trapasso Community House - 46 Church St - Branford

**Meeting was called to order at 8:03am.** Present were Commission Members: R.Squeglia (Chair), E.Cahill, A.Canosa, J.Fennell, F.Hird, K.Ragonese, Shoreline Chamber of Commerce President Dee Jacob, and Perry Maresca (Staff).

**Approval of Minutes**: Motion to accept September Minutes by A.Canosa, seconded by J.Fennell, passed unanimously.

Staff Report: P.Maresca- BioCT held annual BioScience & Beer Mixer. Sold out. Over 400 attended. Horton Group are new owners of LockworksSquare. Fully occupied, spruced up w/painting+landscaping. Paving in spring. TreeLighting Saturday, November30th. Shop,Sip,&Stroll=Thurs, Dec12<sup>th</sup>. Dovetail Custom Kitchens opened at 1036 Main St. The Essex Brassiere opened on North Main St to great reviews. CoCo's on Montowese St to close as owner is retiring. Looking for a tenant in that space. Main Street repaving pushed back to spring'25. Caron's Corner has been sold. New owners expanded hours. ShoreLineEast has service from New London to Stamford w/improved connections in New Haven starting October 7th. Apartments by Stony Creek Brewery are starting to rent for December 1 as first building is almost ready. AtlanticWharf apartments expect to start construction in June 25. Survey underway for residents and property owners regarding ShortTermRentals. The updated list of Branford's top businesses shows strength and stability with a great mix of manufacturing, retail, construction, healthcare and auto sales. Branford's unemployment is lower than State average, which is lower than national average.

Planning & Zoning Report: P.Maresca- Planned Development District approved for 329 East Main St for apartments & storage at x55. Public Hearings continue for an express oil change facility being proposed at 1201 West Main St; 3,000sq' Gas/Retail/FastFood building at 5 East Industrial Rd; Enterprise Auto at 5 Liesl Lane. Premiere Kia proposing an additional facility at 200 & 206 North Main.

**Commissioners' Comments:** F.Hird gave an update on the commission's quest for Federal grant to assist with establishing a Biotech Incubator facility. Successful meeting with multiple parties. Major manufacturer of health equipment is expanding its US manufacturing and growing in Branford.

Shoreline Chamber of Commerce: Dee Jacob- Stepping up the Shop Local Shop Shoreline campaign. Raffle to win thousands of dollars' worth of gift cards. Candidate Forum scheduled for October 15<sup>th</sup>. Health & Wellness Fair on November 2<sup>nd</sup>. Sept brought in 10 new members. Slackline Press one year anniversary. Ribbon Cuttings: StretchLab; Xfinity Store; Pino Insurance; Net90 held at Holiday Inn Express. Workforce Alliance is a good resource for all types of businesses to utilize.

Selectman's Report: Jamie Cosgrove- No report
