- 2. S. Huttner reported on Solar. There will be an informational meeting in the fall the goal is to get information out to as many residents as possible and to remind them that incentives end in December. The most successful way to spread the word is when solar owners host neighborhood gatherings. R. Barnett will explore a contact in Pine Orchard who might be willing to host.
- 3. G. Ames Police Dept. building process is ongoing. T. Bowne ESG completed a walk-through of the animal shelter and other town buildings to suggest ideas for improved energy efficiency. They will work with Affinity Lighting (from New Hampshire) to develop a plan. T. Bowne is inviting G. Ames and V. Chiocchio to this Wednesday's meeting. Discussion regarding the hiring of architects for town projects. We suggest PBC needs to be more involved in the process.

We had a brief discussion regarding embodied carbon in empty town buildings. Sliney school will be left empty in four years. R. Barnett stated the importance of formulating ideas for its use earlier rather than later.

S.Huttner thought that the solar tour or house demonstration could overlap with the residential program.
