- 1. New parking spaces at the main entrance have been completed and the entrance area has been cleaned up.
- 2. The rails on the bridge between the ponds have been replaced by Public Works. Reports are that the Engineering Dept. is in preliminary stages of looking at possible bridge replacement.
- 3. Diana McCarthy-Bercury has been formally asked to intervene on repair/replacement/removal of Pine Gutter Brook footbridge.
- 4. A meeting with Police Lt. Ramey regarding speed humps and No Parking signs was postponed due to weather.
- 5. Purchase order has been issued for the repair of the memorial bench for Noble Proctor.
- 6. Gate on Queach Road is installed. Will be painted later in the year with warmer weather.
- 7. Projects for boulder placements on Queach Rd, Northford Rd, Pisgah Brook footbridge and Lantern Hill Road have been approved. Purchase orders to be issued soon.
- 8. Hanna Drive encroachment issue has been referred to Inland Wetlands. Richard to follow up with the Town Attorney.
- 9. ATV activity has been reported on Beacon Hill. Boulders need to be moved back.
- 10. There was a general discussion about developing guidelines regarding the placement of memorials on Open Space properties.
- 11. A separate discussion was had regarding electric powered vehicles on Open Space properties. There was a general consensus electric motors should be treated the same as all other motorized vehicles. A motion was made by Judy Miller to prohibit all motorized vehicles regardless of the type of motor on all Parks & Open Space properties. The motion was seconded by Wes Beeman. The motion was passed by unanimous consent.
