To consider and if appropriate, approve the recommendation of the Board of Finance to the RTM, with the exception of the 1st Selectman who has elected to take a 0% increase, salaries for the following elected officials increase by 2% for each of their two year term of office: Second Selectman, Third Selectman, Treasurer, Board of Assessment Appeals, RTM Moderator and Finance Clerk.
6. To consider and if appropriate, approve the recommendation of the Board of Finance to the RTM that salaries for the following elected officials increase by 2.5% for each year of their two year term of office: Town Clerk and Tax Collector.
