4. To consider, and if appropriate, adopt a uniform procedure for ordinance enforcement pursuant to Town Meeting Rules (A236-4.1 (d).
5. To Review Branford's Town dock Ordinance and, if appropriate revise to Time Limits and Rights of Appeal.
6. To consider, and if appropriate, create an Ordinance re: Tree Warden & Public Tree Protection in Branford.
7. To consider, and if appropriate, create an Ordinance restricting the use of plastic bags.
8. To consider, and if appropriate, approve a extended tax abatement of real property taxes on properties located at 13-29 Rogers Street and 142-190 Ivy Street for an additional ten years effective the October 1, 2019 Grand List as permitted by section 169-2(4) of Code of Branford. (Housing Development Corp and the Branford Interfaith Housing Corp)
9. To consider, and if appropriate, approve the Town of Branford participating in the Neighborhood Assistance Tax Credit Program.
10. To consider, and if appropriate, approve a Contract between the Town of Branford and the United Public Service Employees Union (UPSEU/COPS) the Branford Police Unit #459, Police Pension Agreement to June 30, 2031.
11. To consider, and if appropriate, approve a Contract between the Town of Branford and the United Public Services Employees Union/COPS, Local #459. To June 30, 2022

13. To consider and, if appropriate, approve the recommendation of the Board of Finance of an appropriation of \$58,294,600 to the Board of Education (Operating Budget + Capital) for fiscal year 2019-2020.
14. To consider and, if appropriate, approve the recommendation of the Board of Finance of an appropriation of \$57,120,112 for all other Town Departments (Operating Budget + Capital) for fiscal year 2019-2020.
15. To consider and, if appropriate, approve the recommendation of the Board of Finance of appropriation of \$60,055 to the Open Space Fund Budget for fiscal year 2019-2020.
16. To consider and if appropriate, approve the recommendation of the Board of Finance of an appropriation of \$14,926 to the Sewer Assessment Fund Budget for fiscal 2019-2020.
