The RTM held an in-person special meeting on Wednesday, July 21, 2021 at 8:00 p.m. at Fire Headquarters, 45 North Main Street, Branford, CT. Rep. Conklin stated Public Services heard this item in committee. He reported it is a straight forward set of transfers, some of which are contractually mandated. This item was approved 5-0 in committee and was put forward for a vote. The item was unanimously approved.

3. To consider, and if appropriate, approve the following transfer requests and resolutions regarding the Dan Cosgrove Animal Shelter facility expansion appropriation:

Rep. Conklin reported, in joint session with Ways and Means, Public Services heard this item. Rep. Conklin made a motion to waive the full reading of the resolution, 2nd by Rep. Brockett and unanimously approved. Rep. Conklin reported Ways and Means voted 5-0 to approve this item and Public Services approved this item 4-1. Rep. Black commented that they met with the construction managers concerning the increased costs of the project.

Rep. Stepanek gave a minority report stating he supports the project but needed additional information regarding costs and energy efficiency.

Other RTM members commented on the project This item passed unanimously in a roll call vote (see attached).

Resolved: That the RTM approves an appropriation from increased undesignated fund balance in the amount of \$650,000. This transfer will increase the Fiscal year 2021 General Fund budget from \$118,867,730 to \$119,517,730 and will be used to partially fund the animal shelter renovation. In addition, the RTM should consider, and if appropriate, approve the following transfer to reflect the impact on the general fund and capital fund.

RESOLUTION AMENDING A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$2,895,000 FOR THE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF THE BRANFORD ANIMAL SHELTER AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$2,895,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN TO MEET SAID APPROPRIATION AND PENDING THE ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE

DRANFORD TOWN CLERK

Section 1. The Resolution adopted September 9, 2020, entitled "RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$2,895,000 FOR THE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF THE BRANFORD ANIMAL SHELTER AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$2,895,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN TO MEET SAID APPROPRIATION AND PENDING THE ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE", which is hereby ratified, confirmed and adopted, is amended by increasing the appropriation and bond authorization by \$1,700,000 to a total of \$4,595,000 as follows:

Section 2. The title of the Resolution is amended to read as follows:

RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$4,595,000 FOR THE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF THE BRANFORD ANIMAL SHELTER AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$4,595,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN TO MEET SAID APPROPRIATION AND PENDING THE ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE

Section 3. Section 2 of the Resolution is amended by substituting the following:

The total estimated cost of the project is \$4,595,000 and is expected to be paid from an estimated \$1,315,500 to be raised for the project pursuant to a capital campaign of public contributions, energy rebates, fund balance from the Town of Branford, contributions from the Town of North Branford, and the balance from the bonds authorized herein.

Section 4. The first sentence of section 3 of the Resolution is amended to read as follows:

"To meet said appropriation, \$4,595,000 bonds of the Town or so much thereof as shall be necessary for such purpose, shall be issued, maturing not later than the twentieth year after their date."

Section 5. The Resolution is further amended by substituting the amount of \$4,595,000 for \$2,895,000, wherever it appears in the Resolution.

While i understand "correspondence" is not allowed at special meetings, I ask that an RTM representative or member of the pubic read the following short statement during the animal shelter agenda item. Unfortunately, my illness and the increasing effects of chemo prevent me from attending tonight's meeting,

"Although I take strong exception to a number of actions taken by public officials during the animal shelter planning process--some I regard as underhanded, non-transparent, and, quite frankly, dishonest--I nevertheless encourage the RTM to approve the appropriation of the additional \$1.7M for the shelter construction.

Given that, in my experience, the RTM never devotes the time or effort to study a matter adequately, any additional time devoted to the decision would simply be a waste of time. In addition, in my nearly 14 years of being actively involved in local politics, I have seen amounts in excess of \$1.7 M spent far more foolishly than towards a much-needed and beautiful building dedicated to one of Branford's greatest citizens."
