- 4. To consider and make a recommendation to the full RTM regarding repeal of ordinances regarding piggeries. Sec . 118-4 This ordinance is duplicative of zoning regulations regulating large animals, Zoning Regulation 37A (2).
- 5. To review and consider, recommending appropriate action, if any, to the full RTM regarding revision to Code of Ethics.
- 6. Other business may be added to the agenda by 2/3 vote of the committee. It is expected that discussion of a proposed Blight ordinance will be held at a future Special Meeting. A proposed draft is currently being reviewed by town staff.
