- 5. Public Forum A. Pulcinella read a letter from Chris Walston of CW Shellfish Company LLC and Brendan Smith of Thimble Island Oyster Company seeking a change in the Jarvis Creek co-management agreement. They seek to change the lease to the lot per acre (\$50) instead of exchange for littleneck clams The reasoning for the change in the agreement is that littleneck clam prices far exceed the price per acre. A short discussion ensued. On a motion by D, Stienhardt and seconded by M.Hallier and unanimously agreed upon by the Commission,the Commission shall change the Co-Management lease agreement from payment in littleneck clams to \$50.00 per acre
- 6. <u>Communications and Bills</u> A detailed bill from Kelsey's Boat Yard for prepping the Commission Shellfish Boat for uthe season was recieved. On a motion by D. Stienhardt and seconded by B. Lilliquist, the Commission unanimously agreed to pay the \$1,387 bill.

- 8. Budget Report The report was distributed to the Commissioners. No Discussion
- 9. Enforcement Report M. Hallier checked two boaters without permits, and 1 boater not displaying area markers, bamboo stakes were agreed upon at the north end of Bear Island.

- 11 Old Business Yale University/Horse reviewed and passed the proposal. The Commission returned the CTDEEP form concerning replacement of Rte 146 wall stating the project will not impact the shellfish beds. Chris Walston has made payment and is current
