Clean Energy Ad Hoc Committee Meeting Minutes 1/25/21

- 1. Chair S. McCarthy called the meeting to order at approximately 5:00.
- 2. The minutes of 12/14/20 were approved on a motion by B. Babcock and a second by D. Rabin.
- 3. M. Cohen reported on the successful progress of the HeatSmart program.
- 4. D. Bercury led discussion about: Energy assistance programs for customers having difficulty paying utility bills. Blue Earth composting and anerobic digestion, including the potential for initiating a facility somewhere along the CT shoreline for Branford and several neighboring towns.
 - -Biofuels- B. Horne and M. Cox will investigate how we might incorporate biofuels in the committee's work and the energy plan.
 - -D. Bercury has obtained a grant of the hardware required for a Solar Hot Water (SHW) system at the Animal Shelter. D. Bercury offered to help the schools and other agencies to apply for similar SHW grants.
 - -She is looking for parties interested in participating in an April 22 Earth Day celebration. J. Prins suggested soliciting the school principals.
- 5. S. Huttner reported that a new round of DERA (Diesel Emissions Reduction Act) is underway. The Town is prioritizing Town vehicles to electrify. She is also establishing a transportation working group that will include Donna Laich.
- 6. B. Babcock and E. Cahill are working with Eversource to identify and publicize programs for energy incentives for business.
- 7. E Mahler reported that the tax credit for batteries has been extended for another 2 years, has been expanded to include batteries charged by grid power of 75% or more renewables, and will be supported by a state loan program. Three of our solar installers are interested in doing a Q&A educational webinar.
- 8. Public Comment: Several members of the public asked questions about Electric Vehicle battery sustainability, solar projects, and the Town's projects.
- 9. Adjournment was moved by B. Babcock, seconded by E. Mahler and voted at approximately 6:05. The meeting was adjourned at 6:06 pm.
