TRAFFIC COMMITTEE MINUTES FROM November 8, 2021

The meeting called to order at 5:00 p.m.

Approval of Minutes from September 13, 2021

Motion made by Commissioner Marcus to approve the minutes and seconded by Commissioner Sousoulas. Vote unanimous.

Traffic Requests:

1. Request for additional signage at 59 Parish Farm Road due to line of sight issue. The area was assessed by the Traffic Committee and determined there was no line of sight issue. Committee recommends no action.
2. Request for Private Road/no outlet sign on Coheco Avenue. Committee recommends no action.
3. Follow-up on Rt 146 Bridge Improvements. The town Engineer has started the application process. Commissioner Austin provided an update regarding the meetings and correspondence that has been received concerning traffic, parking, pedestrian safety and lighting along RT 146 in Sybil Creek business area. Committee concurs resolving these issues will involve several departments including the Engineering and State DOT. Committee recommends no action.
3. Follow-up on request to remove stanchions on Linden Ave. Traffic Committee is waiting to hear from the association and recommends deferred to the next meeting.

4. Follow-up on line of sight issue at the corner of Isabel Lane and South Montowese St. Lt. Ramey spoke to the resident. The resident has two weeks to trim the hedge back, if it is not completed within that timeframe it will be referred to the State DOT for action. The Traffic Committee will go onsite to assess whether the neighbor's belgin blocks pose a safety issue.
