**Sewer Access Applications**

- a. 0 Buckley Road

Mr. Vincent Giordano presents maps, for a 12 unit, residential development on this property.

Will have a gravity sewer extension connecting to the property, 8" main. No pumps.

Each building permit unit is subject to the \$6,000.00 sewer access charge.

A motion was made to approve the sewer access application, subject to a capacity study and sewer agreement by Mr. Steinhardt, and seconded by Ms. Larrieu. Motion carries unanimously.

**Reports:**

**Superintendent Brian Devlin**

Superintendent Brian Devlin, presented his report.

The Septic Receiving bid was won by Kovacs Construction. Depending on product availability will determine when the project will begin.

Septic Waste Processed 1,173,850 – Septic Revenues \$77,100.50

Plant Operators serviced mechanical bar screen, R A S pumps, gravity belt thickener pump, tanker truck loading pump, and all three primary sludge pumps.

Drained #1 Secondary clarifier and clean and inspected tank. Adjusted chains on the two primary clarifiers. Installed new belt on odor control fan. Installed spray hoses on secondary basin tanks. Clean UV channel.

Collection System crew cleaned and inspected pump stations weekly. Holding tank pump outs done weekly. Repaired hoist motor. Installed new float at Little Bay Pump Station. Pulled pumps at Hemlock, Summer Island, Supply Pond, Pages, and Damascus pump stations due to rag issues. Change out pump at Squire Hill Pump Station. New camera installed in camera van. Jetted 8,933 feet of sewer line.

Sleeving of sewer pipes will be performed, beginning tonight, at Sybil.

**Engineer John Hoefflerle**

Engineer John Hoefflerle said he met with the owner of Rose Hill Road, Paul Santa Barbara. Also met with Doug Anderson. They discussed large open space for a 10 lot property. Sewer access has already been approved. A memorandum at that time had an interest between the developer and the Town to sewer the entire system, and hook up Pent Road residents. The money has been appropriated. 1.1 million dollars at the time.

Working on Town's Contributions and developers.

Keeping options in forefront to keep assessments down.
