Branford residents can participate in a food scrap drop off program at the Transfer Station. The Town's partner, Blue Earth Compost, will collect it, turn it into compost and renewable energy.

The program is **free of charge** and helps the Town of Branford become more environmentally friendly. Just bring your food scraps in a container or compostable bag to the Transfer Station and deposit them into the specially marked containers. Bio Bags are available at the Transfer Station.

#### WHAT TO RECYCLE

## **Paper Products:**

Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, office paper, junk mail, juice boxes, broth boxes, frozen food boxes & paperboard (cereal boxes, pasta boxes, paper towel rolls)

#### **HOW TO RECYCLE**

Flatten and bundle together in a brown paper grocery bag.




No ice cream containers No paper with oil or grease

DO NOT RECYCLE

No plastic bags or plastic film No greasy pizza boxes

#### **Corrugated Cardboard:**

Cardboard with three layered edge



Clean. Flattened, cut or folded to 3'x3' size or smaller pieces preferred. Tie with string and leave next to blue bin.



No unflattened boxes, packing material. Do not mix with newspaper/paperboard.

# **Glass Food Containers:**

Glass bottles or jars used to package food or beverage products



Clean and place loose in the blue bin



No mirrors, dishes, light bulbs No windows No broken glass No ceramics No plastic bags or plastic film

## **Metal Food Containers:**

Any metallic food or beverage can, plate or tray used to package food or beverage products, aluminum foil and plates



Clean and place loose in the blue bin.



No scrap metal, pots or pans No coat hangers No paint cans or aerosol cans No extension cords No propane tanks No plastic bags or plastic film

#### Rigid Plastic Containers, #1 thru #7:

Food, Fruit, and Beverage containers (yogurt containers, laundry jugs, milk jugs, etc.)



Check to make sure the number in the small triangle on the container shows the type of plastic #1 - #7



# Clean and place loose in the blue bin.




(EVEN IF IT'S RAINING **NO PLASTIC BAGS!)** 

No motor oil, pesticide bottles, laundry baskets, large items, toys, planters, etc. No Styrofoam No plastic bags or plastic film No black takeout food containers No plastic envelopes, bubble wrap or packaging peanuts

# **Curbside Garbage & Recycling Collection Routes**



#### \*Please make sure your materials are to the curb by midnight before your collection day.\*

When there is a holiday that falls on or before your collection day there will be a one-day delay. In this case, place your materials at the curb the next day. Never use plastic bags for recycling or leaf collection.

## **Monday Collection**

Branford Hills; Short Beach including all of Short Beach Rd., Plant Rd., and Vineyard Rd.; Pawson Park & Indian Neck including Limewood Ave. and Tyler Ave.

#### **Tuesday Collection**

Cherry Hill / Brushy Plains; Center of Town including North Main Street & East Main Street until they intersect near the High School.

## **Wednesday Collection**

Blackstone Acres / Knollwood area / Pine Orchard Rd. from armory to the railroad tracks; Hotchkiss Grove starting after Tyler Ave.; Branford Point including Rock Pasture, Berry Patch, and Swift St. / West End Ave.; Supply Pond area including Chestnut St. north of Route 1; Mill Plain / Queach area; the northeast part of town including East Main after it joins Route 1.

# **Thursday Collection**

Stony Creek including all of Stony Creek Rd. and Leetes Island Rd. until I-95; Pine Orchard, both Sunset Hill area and shore area; Pepperwood and Acorn area; Damascus Rd. and everything off of it including Windmill Hill, Featherbed and Gould Lane area.

Please try to arrive at least a half an hour before closing time.

You can also dispose of the following items at the Transfer Station:

- Clothing, shoes & linens
- Books, CDs, VHS, DVDs, & video games
- Waste Oil please come inside the office to sign the waiver
- Electronic Equipment (TV's, Computers, etc)
- Refrigerators & Air Conditioners - must remove the door
- Rechargeable batteries & cell phones
- Prescription glasses
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Scrap Metal
- Brush & Leaves (no grass clippings)
- Large Cardboard (no styrofoam)
- Mattresses/Bulky Furniture

#### TRASH CONTAINER REQUIREMENTS:

- must be less than 50 gallons in size
- must weigh less than 50 pounds when full
- must have handles

## RECYCLING CONTAINER **REQUIREMENTS:**

- must be 22 gallon blue bin
- must not have any plastic bags
- must be sorted recyclables per guidelines
- must weigh less than 50 pounds Bins available at the Transfer Station at no charge
