Job Summary:

The purposes of this position is to perform a variety of non-sworn duties in the enforcement in guidance and control of vehicular and/or pedestrian traffic at places such as schools, churches, crossings, beaches, and Town events.

- Monitor traffic flow to locate safe gaps through which pedestrians/students can cross streets
- Direct or escort pedestrians/students across streets, stopping traffic as necessary
- Direct traffic movement or warn of hazards, using signs, flags, lanterns, and hand signals
- Learn the location and purpose of street traffic signs within assigned patrol areas
- Discuss traffic routing plans and control point locations with superiors
- Maintain thorough knowledge of the latest traffic and parking regulations
- Assists other departments as needed to promote a team effort to serve the public
