



Covid Booster Shots: It is recommended you get the same brand as your first shots. There are plenty of doses and locations giving them: Walgreens, CVS, Walmart. Griffin Health is holding daily clinics at Trinity Church, Monday-Saturday 1:00 pm-5:00 pm, no appointment needed. Click here for the latest info: Vaccine Locations

Moderna: The CDC has approved a third shot only for those who are immunocompromised, recipients must sign an attestation that they meet the CDC criteria. Approval of a Moderna booster shot for anyone age 65+is expected within the next two weeks. Stay tuned.

Pfizer: The CDC has approved a Pfizer booster shot for anyone age 65+, or immunocompromised. You can schedule a Pfizer booster on Yale's MyChart, CVS, Walgreens, Walmart, or Rite Aid.

Johnson & Johnson: CDC hasn't approved any J&J boosters yet.

Medicare Open Enrollment is Oct.15-Dec 7. Changes take effect Jan. 1, 2022. During this time you can: switch between original Medicare and Medicare Advantage, join or change your Medicare Advantage Plan or prescription plan (Part D). Figuring out what to do can be overwhelming; if you are happy with your coverage you do not need to do anything. Want some guidance? Home Heating Help: We are scheduling appointments for those who heat with oil, kero, & propane. If your income is less than \$39,027 (single) or \$51,035 (2) you might be eligible. This year there is **no asset limit**. You'll get an appointment letter in the mail if you applied with us last year. New to the program? Absentee ballots: COVID-19 continues to be one of the qualifying reasons for voting via absentee ballot. Registered voters may request an application from the Town Clerk office by calling (203) 315-0678, or <u>Click here to print the application</u>. Drop off your absentee ballot request in the drop box outside of Town Hall; an official ballot will then be mailed to you. Call Blair if you need a ride to vote in person.
