NOTES

REGULATION OF INLAND WETLANDS AND WATERCOURSES:

As of January 16, 1974, all inland wetlands and all watercourses have been regulated and protected by the Branford Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Agency [the Agency] under the Inland Wetland and Watercourses Regulations [IWWR] of the Town of Branford. A permit is required <u>BEFORE</u> any regulated activity may be undertaken which may impact any inland wetland or watercourse.

- 1.) Activities which may impact wetlands/watercourses may include, but are not limited to, clearing of vegetation, grubbing, grading, blasting, excavating, filling, paving, constructing, and alteration of storm water discharge. See Section 2.1 of the IWWR for complete definition of Regulated Activity.
- 2.) Any activity identified in (1) above which is proposed within, or within 100 feet of, a wetland or watercourse requires a permit unless the Agency determines that the activities will cause no impacts to wetlands and watercourses. Any activities undertaken outside of this 100 foot "upland review area", which may impact wetlands/watercourses will also require a permit.
- 3.) Wetlands are identified by soils and some may not "look" like wetlands. If the Agency determines that wetlands exist or may exist, it will require that they be delineated by a soils scientist.
- 4.) The Agency is the entity authorized by the CGS to make the final determination as to whether a body of water, stream, ditch, ponded water, etc. meets the criteria of a watercourse set forth in the definition.
- 5.) Any person who violates any provision of the Branford IWWR shall be subject to fines of up to one thousand dollars (\$1000) per day as authorized by the CGS, IWWR, and Town Ordinance.

TIME FRAME:

This form is NOT AN APPLICATION for permit. The purpose of submission of this form with required materials is to determine whether or not a permit is needed. If the Agency determines that you will need a permit you must submit an application to the Agency for an Inland Wetland Permit. An application for permit will be processed according to time frame designated by the State of Connecticut General Statutes as follows:

The Inland Wetland Commission meets the second Thursday of each month. In order for an application to be officially "received" at a meeting, it must be submitted by 4:30 pm on the day before the meeting. The Commission cannot make a decision until at least fourteen days after that meeting. The Inland Wetlands Enforcement Officer may issue permits for minor applications. In this case, the time frames do not apply.
