# Canoe Brook Center Senior Bus Transportation (203)315-0681

Canoe Brook Center has three buses, two 18 passenger buses and one 12 passenger bus that are driven by CDL licensed bus drivers employed part-time by the Town of Branford.

Passengers must be Branford residents age 60+, current Canoe Brook members, oriented, ambulatory and independent. Our buses have three steps that must be climbed to enter the bus; you must be able to enter the vehicle unassisted. Canoe Brook membership is \$8 a year.

Service is curb-to-curb. Should you need hands on assistance or wheelchair transportation call Greater New Haven Transit District's MyRide at (203)-288-6282 as they provide wheelchair transport to qualifying Branford residents.

<u>Reservations</u> can be made by calling our transportation office (203) 315-0681.

All new passengers will be evaluated prior to scheduling a ride.

Where you live determines which store we will take you to. You have approximately 1.5 hours to shop, you must be able to carry your groceries into your home. Drivers are not allowed to enter your home. There is a **4 bag limit** per house (plastic/paper size.)

### Branford Medical Transportation

Medical Transportation is available to Branford residents 21 years of age or older. We have 3 Subaru Forester cars that are provided by the Town of Branford and a team of dedicated volunteer drivers. This service is curb to curb. You must be able to get in and out of the car unassisted. All new passengers will be evaluated prior to scheduling a ride.

# For safety reasons we are unable to transport any passengers who have undergone a procedure with any kind of sedation.

Transportation is provided to doctors' offices in Branford, East Haven, New Haven, Guilford, Madison, and the VA.

The earliest appointment is 9:00 a.m. and last pick up from a doctors office is 2:30 p.m.

#### All cars are off the road by 3:00pm

Reservations: Call (203)315-0681 as soon as you know you have a doctor's appointment. Our schedule fills up fast and we may not always be able to accommodate your request so —book early! All new passengers will be evaluated prior to booking a ride.
